Cal State/UC application review

This session will go in-depth with both the Cal State application (csumentor.edu) and the UC application (admission.universityofcalifornia.edu). If students have a laptop it will be helpful for them to bring it with them so that they can update their applications in real time. Students should also bring a copy of their most recent transcript.
