## Apply Now! Scholarship to Otis Summer of Art for Ryman Arts students!

If you would like to attend a full time studio art and design program at Otis College from July 1-26 this summer, Otis College has generously offered two full scholarships to Ryman Arts. Ryman Arts students and alumni are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Please only apply if you are available to attend classes at Otis College Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 4:20 p.m. from July 1-26. Housing is not provided in the scholarship.

If you do not need a scholarship in order to attend, disregard this flyer and just follow the application instructions on the Otis Summer of Art website.

### To apply for a full scholarship, follow these steps:

1. Read about Otis Summer of Art online at [www.otis.edu/summer-art](http://www.otis.edu/summer-art)
2. Complete and submit the Registration: Scholarship Contingent Form. Found on the scholarships page: [www.otis.edu/soa/scholarships](http://www.otis.edu/soa/scholarships).
3. Write a one-page essay about why you would like to attend Otis Summer of Art.
4. Make sure your Ryman Arts portfolio has all your work from this semester in it, since we'll be looking at it as part of your application. We will be taking the portfolios from campus on March 30-31 during classes.
5. Turn in to Rebecca on or before **March 25, 2019**
  - Essay
  - Official** High School transcript
  - A copy of your family's 2018 federal tax return (or 2017 if 2018 is not available)

If you are not accepted for the Ryman Arts scholarship, but still want to apply for a scholarship directly through Otis, then go to the Summer of Art scholarship page and follow instructions (You will need to submit photographs of your artwork in a program called Slideroom to submit your portfolio, in that case).
