One Ryman Arts student will receive a full scholarship to a two week residential, visual arts workshop at Idyllwild Arts, on the basis of application materials and financial need.

Since 1950, the Idyllwild Arts Summer Program has created a unique learning environment for children, youth, and adults through an intensive, individual exploration of the arts. Located in the mountains near Palm Springs, the program's 205-acre campus provides an outstanding setting for learning art with other teens.

At Idyllwild, students live on campus in dorms and take art classes every day for two weeks. This immersive program, while demanding, provides a competition-free environment. An exceptional faculty works closely with each student, stressing individual growth while encouraging achievement.
