

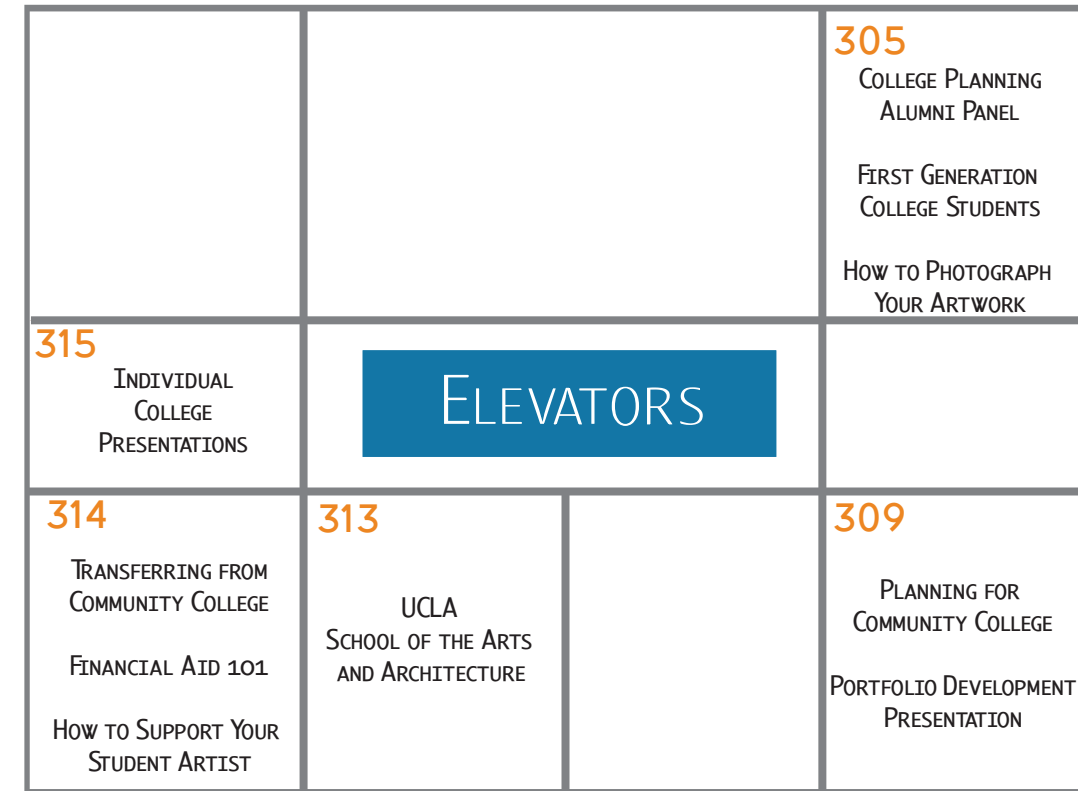

Transferring from Community College to a Four Year School

10:00 — 11:00 AM

Are you considering attending community college first before transferring to a four-year college? If so, then make sure to attend this session.
